Company Information Packet

Being a member of Head to Toe Dance Company is a rewarding, exciting and educational program for dancers ages 5 -18. Our program will require an "above and beyond" commitment from each dancer and his or her family.

Our dancers learn so much more than dances and steps, they develop confidence in themselves. Being a part of our team will enhance your child's life in so many ways. She will make strong bonds with the dancers on her team, learn about teamwork and dedication, grow tremendously in her dance abilities and have many opportunities to perform throughout the year.

Expectations

As you can see, dance offers so much to its students. Our Company Dancers develop strong and flexible minds and bodies. They explore artistic and creative movement and have many opportunities to perform, learn and work as a team. They also cultivate long lasting traits such as confidence, leadership and dedication.

To be honest, competitive, intensive dance study is an expensive and time consuming endeavor, but it is worth it to see our dancers succeed. I want you and your dancer to know what is expected from anyone in our elite Dance Company. Our dancers are worth the investment of time and money!

Tuition - All Company members will be enrolled in automatic payment for tuition, which is year round. Tuition is \$175 monthly in the summer months and includes unlimited classes. During the school year, tuition is \$190 for Minis, \$220 for Juniors, and \$240 for Seniors. Optional classes added, in addition to the required classes, are \$20 a class per month, or we offer unlimited classes for \$300 per month.

Costumes – Company members compete in an average of 3- 4 dances. Costumes average approximately \$75 each. We also purchase costumes in the spring for our annual recital. Some recital costumes are "bring from home costumes" or are recycled from other dances we have previously done in order to defray costs.

Competitions / Conventions – Competitions and Conventions average approximately \$295 per event.

Choreography Fees - All Company group dances will incur a choreography fee. H2T staff Choreographer fees are \$35 per dance. Guest Choreographer fees are \$100 per dance. Juniors and Seniors will have one Guest Choreographer dance. Senior small group will have one additional Guest Choreographer dance. Minis will only have H2T staff Choreographer.

ALL families are required to provide credit card and bank account information to have on file.



Company Events Throughout the year

While the specific events for next year are not on our calendar yet, this should give you an idea of what to expect for your child's involvement on our team.

Fall Semester: In House Dance Convention, Saturday Rehearsals (average 2x per month), 2 Christmas Performances, Optional one day Convention in Dallas (October), Optional two-day Convention in San Marcos (November).

Spring Semester: Dance Convention, 2-4 Competitions in Central Texas, Founder's Day Performance, Saturday Rehearsals (average 2x per month).

Summer: Unlimited Classes! Camps - several optional camps to choose from and one Company Camp which is required for all Company members.

<u> Classes – School Year</u>

Our **Company Members** must take required classes as indicated below.

- * **Minis Company** Combo 1 (Ballet, Lyrical & Tap), Combo 2 (Jazz, Hip Hop & Acro), Acro, 1 Rehearsal
- * **Junior Company** Ballet, Jazz, Acro, Contemporary, Tap/Hip Hop Combo class & 2 Rehearsals.
- * Senior Company Ballet, Jazz, Acro, Contemporary, Tap, Hip Hop & 2 Rehearsals.

Students can also take classes in Pointe, Musical Theater, Stretch & Strengthen and Turns & Progressions according to their interests at an additional \$20 per class per month.

Dancers can prepare for audition by focusing on increasing their flexibility and practicing their turns and leaps. Evaluations being held on May 11th (see previous page) can help your student prepare for the audition experience.

Dress Code: Please wear a black leotard, black leggings and jazz shoes. Hair should be in a neat bun, light makeup optional, and no jewelry or nail polish.

Dancers will demonstrate their splits, pirouettes and leaps. They will then learn a short combination and perform it as well. They will also have the opportunity to demonstrate their skills through improvisation.
